Mental Health Out-Patient Programs Children's Sexual Abuse Program For children birth to age 17

THE PROGRAM

The goal of the Child and Youth Sexual Abuse Response Program is to provide crisis, short term and long term counselling to those children and youth who have been sexually victimized or who are acting out sexually as well as the non-offending members of their families.

The Child and Youth Sexual Abuse Response Program is part of the Ross Memorial Hospital Community Counselling Services funded by the Ministry of Community and Social Services. The Crisis Support staff works closely with the Kawartha-Haliburton Children's Aid Society to assess and screen referrals.

The counselling staff are qualified and experienced therapists who specialize in working with children and their families.

PRINCIPLES OF THE SERVICE

We believe in:

- A systems response that enhances the dignity and strengths of our clients.
- Providing safe supportive, educational and informed services.
- A commitment to quality service demonstrated though respect and understanding.
- Promoting comprehensive service planning though partnerships with our families and other community resources.

CONFIDENTIALITY

All requests for service are handled in the strictest confidence and are free of charge to all residents of Victoria County.

In order to protect your confidentiality your written approval is required prior to the release of any information either verbal or written, except in circumstances where the legal system requires disclosure.

WHO WE HELP

This service offers professional counselling to child and youth victims under the age of 18 years and to the non-offending members of their families. The program incorporates two primary components:

- A) A Crisis/Support service to address immediate post disclosure needs.
- B) The treatment clinicians provide ongoing treatment, both long and short term for sexual abuse victims, victims of date rape, sexual assault victims, children demonstrating sexualized behaviour, and non-offending members of their families.

OUR ROLE CAN INCLUDE

- Completing assessments and individual service plans, in consultation with clients
- · Links with community services and resources
- Providing support, education and counselling
- Providing court support as required
- Teaching and enhancing coping skills
- Systems/service advocacy

REFERRAL PROCESS

Self-referrals are welcomed, as are referrals from family members, or helping professionals. All referrals will be processed though the Crisis Support Worker of the Child Sexual Abuse Response Program who is available at:
