

Hip & Knee Surgery Wait Times



Tracking our Hip and Knee Surgery Wait Times is an important way to measure our patients' access to care. Tracking surgery wait times helps the hospital to ensure that our patients are receiving their surgeries within a reasonable timeframe. Surgery wait times are measures from the day the patient and physician decide that surgery is required to the date that the procedure takes place. The chart below shows our progress meeting provincial wait time targets. The wait times are measured at the 90th percentile, which means the chart shows the maximum amount of time (in days) in which 9 out of 10 patients wait to have hip or knee surgery.
