

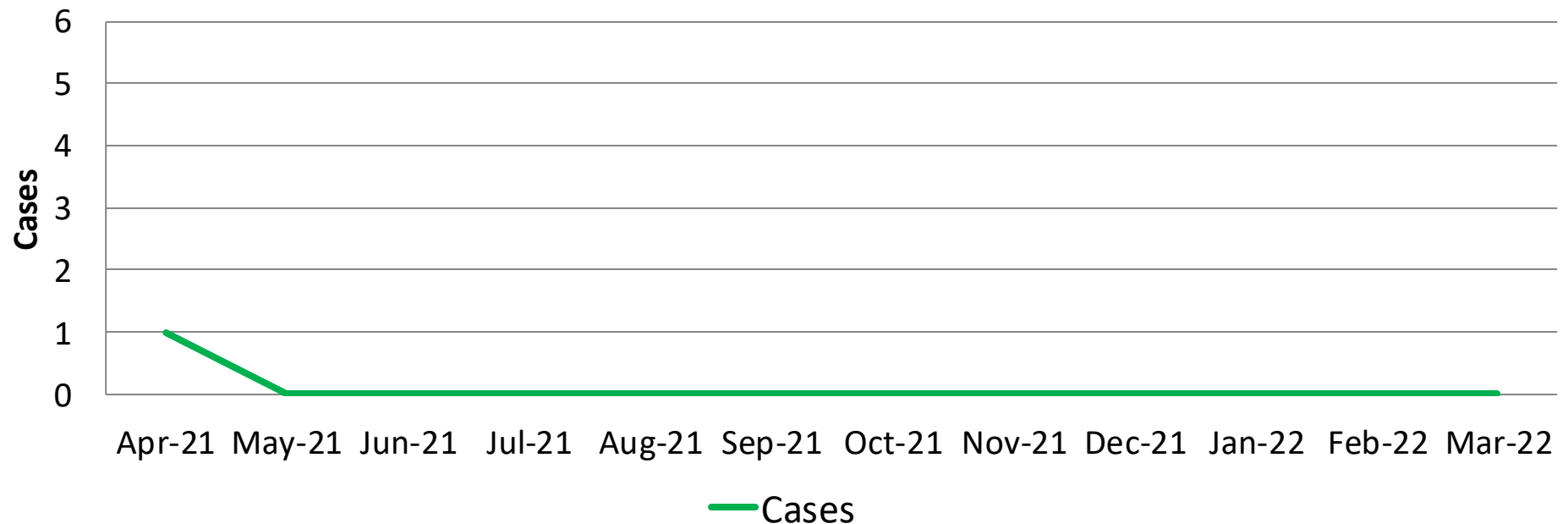
Methicillin-Resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA)

Staphylococcus aureus is a germ that lives on the skin and mucous membranes of healthy people. Occasionally, *staphylococcus aureus* can cause an infection. When *Staphylococcus aureus* develops a resistance to certain antibiotics, it is called Methicillin-Resistant *Staphylococcus Aureus*, or MRSA
