Don't wait to seek care. Visit the Emergency Department if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms:







A BROKEN BONE or wound requiring stitches











and disorientation





**SUDDEN SEVERE** HEADACHE, WEAKNESS, vision problems, numbness/tingling, trouble speaking, dizziness

**ABDOMINAL PAIN** or severe diarrhea with signs of dehydration

#### If you are visiting the Emergency Department:

- Wear a mask at all times and do not bring food or drink
- Bring your health card and all of your current medications
